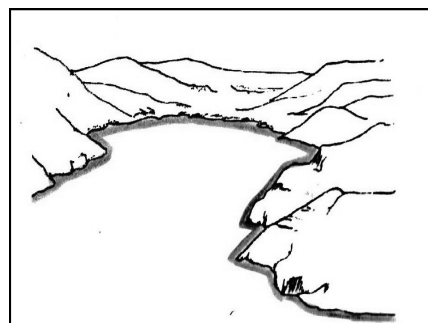
A **fjord** is a narrow, deep inlet of sea, usually bordered by steep cliffs.

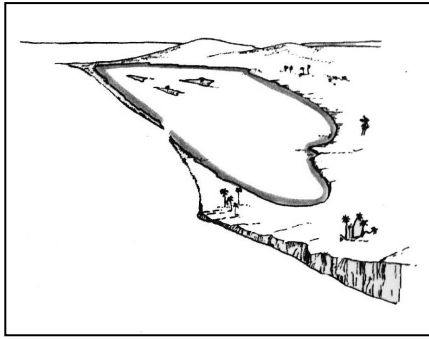


A **bay** is an inlet of a sea or lake. It is usually smaller than a gulf.

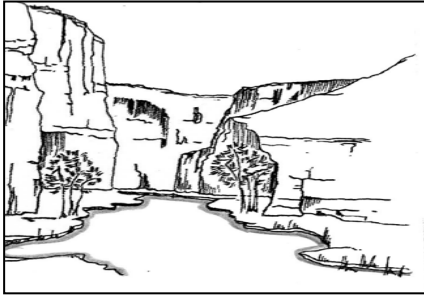


A **lagoon** is an area of water separated from the sea by a narrow stretch of land. It is not as deep as the sea and is often dotted with small islands.

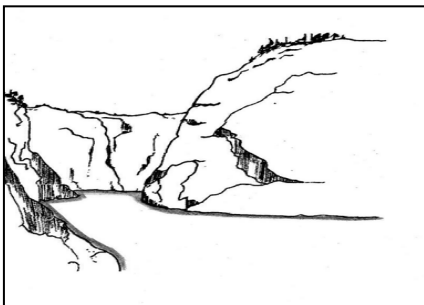
