
GEOMETRY






A straight line is called **horizontal straight line** when it follows the direction of still water.

Horizon: the line that separates the sky from the sea.



A straight line is called **vertical straight line** when it follows the direction of a plumb line.



A straight line is called **oblique straight line** when it follows neither the direction of still water, nor the direction of a plumb line.



A *curved line* changes its direction continually from point to point.



A line is called **broken** when two or more line segments are attached to one another.
