



NOMENCLATURE OF A RECTANGLE



The part of a plane in a
rectangle is called a
surface.



The line segments which bound a rectangle are called *sides*.



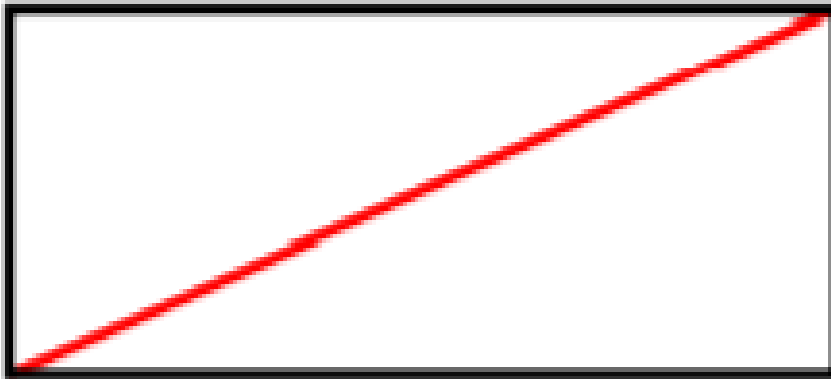
Each side of the rectangle
takes the name *base*.



The total of the sides of a rectangle is called *perimeter*.



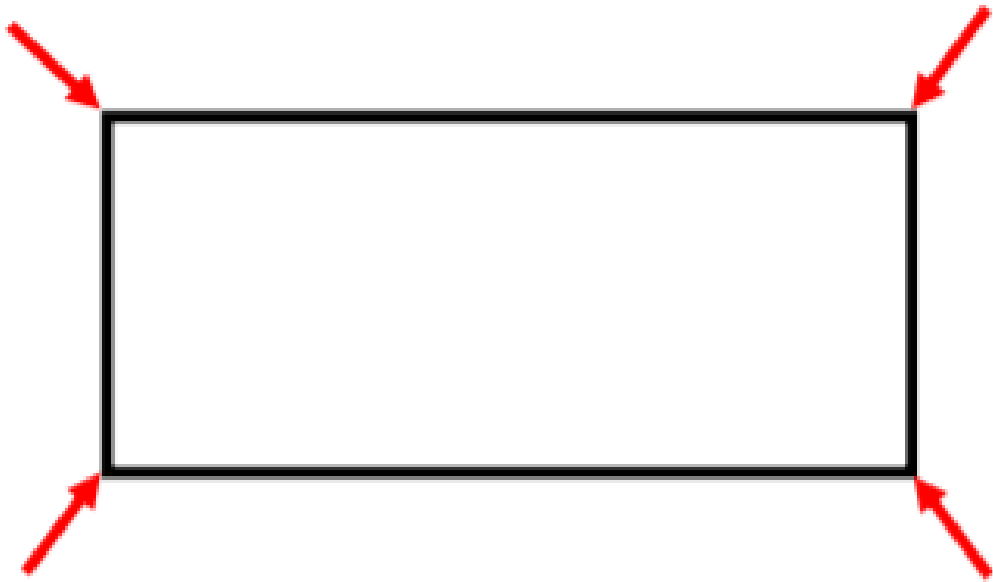
The perpendicular distance drawn between two opposite sides is called the *altitude*.



Each line segment which joins opposite vertices of a rectangle is called a *diagonal*.



Each part of a plane enclosed between two consecutive sides of a rectangle is called an *angle*.



The points where two sides of a rectangle meet are called *vertices*.
