



RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN ANGLES




Two angles with a common side are called *adjacent*.




Two angles which share a vertex and whose sides come together to make continuing lines are called *linear pair*.



Two angles whose sum is equal to a right angle therefore equal to 90° are called *complementary* angles.



Two angles whose sum is equal to a straight angle therefore equal to 180° are called *supplementary* angles.



Two adjacent angles whose non-common sides form a straight angle are called *vertically opposite*.
