



TYPES OF ROOTS



A *tap root* is one which descends deeply into the ground and generally produces branches.

(Oak, Wallflower, Bean)

English: tap - to pierce



A fasciculate root

is a root that has several generally fibrous (threadlike) roots. This type of root is included among the adventitious.

(Grass)

Latin: fiber - thread fascicle - a bunch, cluster
