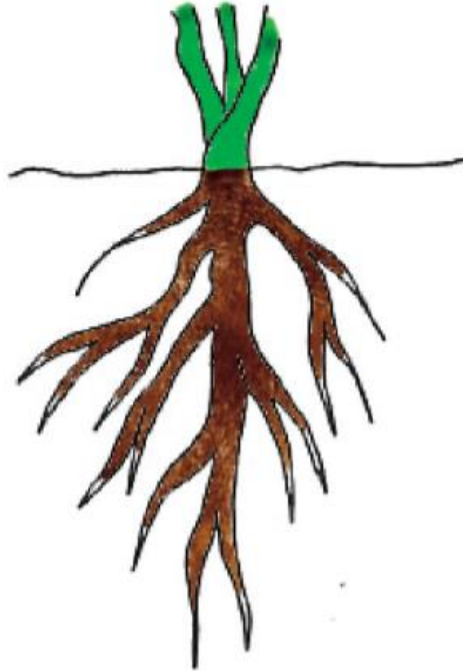

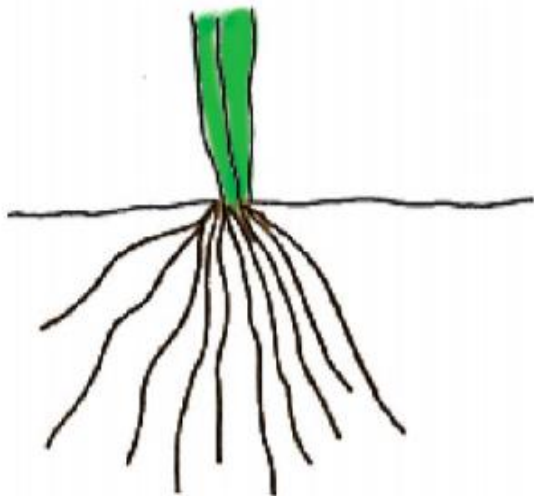
TYPES OF ROOTS



A ***tap root*** is one which descends deeply into the ground and generally produces branches.

(Oak, Wallflower, Bean)

English: *tap* - to pierce



A ***fasciculate root*** is a root that has several generally fibrous (threadlike) roots. This type of root is included among the adventitious.

(Grass)

Latin: *fiber* - thread
fascicle - a bunch,
cluster
